Event Date and Description: [2011-07-10 No Alcohol or Drugs While Working or Driving](#)

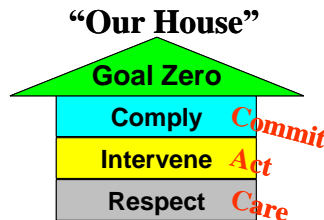
<u>What happened:</u> A worker arrived at the heliport impaired.
<u>Which Life Saving Rule(s) involved:</u> #9 – No alcohol or drugs while working or driving.
<u>Investigation results:</u> Worker arrived on site impaired.
<u>Action taken:</u> Worker's company was notified, individual was placed on Shell's no fly list and terminated by employing company.
<u>Key Learning Points:</u> If you choose to violate the rules, you choose not to work for Shell.

It is about saving lives, and it is working.

Everyone should ensure that we know the rules, follow the rules, and always intervene if there is the potential for unsafe behaviors or conditions. This applies to everyone: peers, supervisors, and visitors.

If in doubt, always consult your supervisor.
