

Learning from Life Saving Rule events

The following is a short summary of a Life Saving Rule event, investigation, follow up, and learning opportunities.

It is intended to help share information and learn from each event to prevent future occurrences. It is about Saving Lives.

Event Date and Description: [2009-11-20 No alcohol or drugs while working or driving](#)

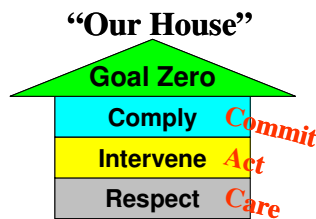
What happened: A worker showed up at the Heliport, went through the flight briefing and flew offshore. After the platform orientation the individual was asked if he had been drinking (smelled of alcohol). He agreed to a swab test. Test showed alcohol in his system at a level between 0.08 and 0.10.
What rule was Violated: No alcohol or drugs while working or driving
Investigation results: Event was conclusive following swab test
Action taken: Worker was removed from location.
Key Learning Points: Know the rules and follow them

It is about saving lives, and it is working.

Everyone should ensure that we know the rules, follow the rules, and always intervene if there is the potential for unsafe behaviors or conditions. This applies to everyone: peers, supervisors, and visitors.

If in doubt, always consult your supervisor.
